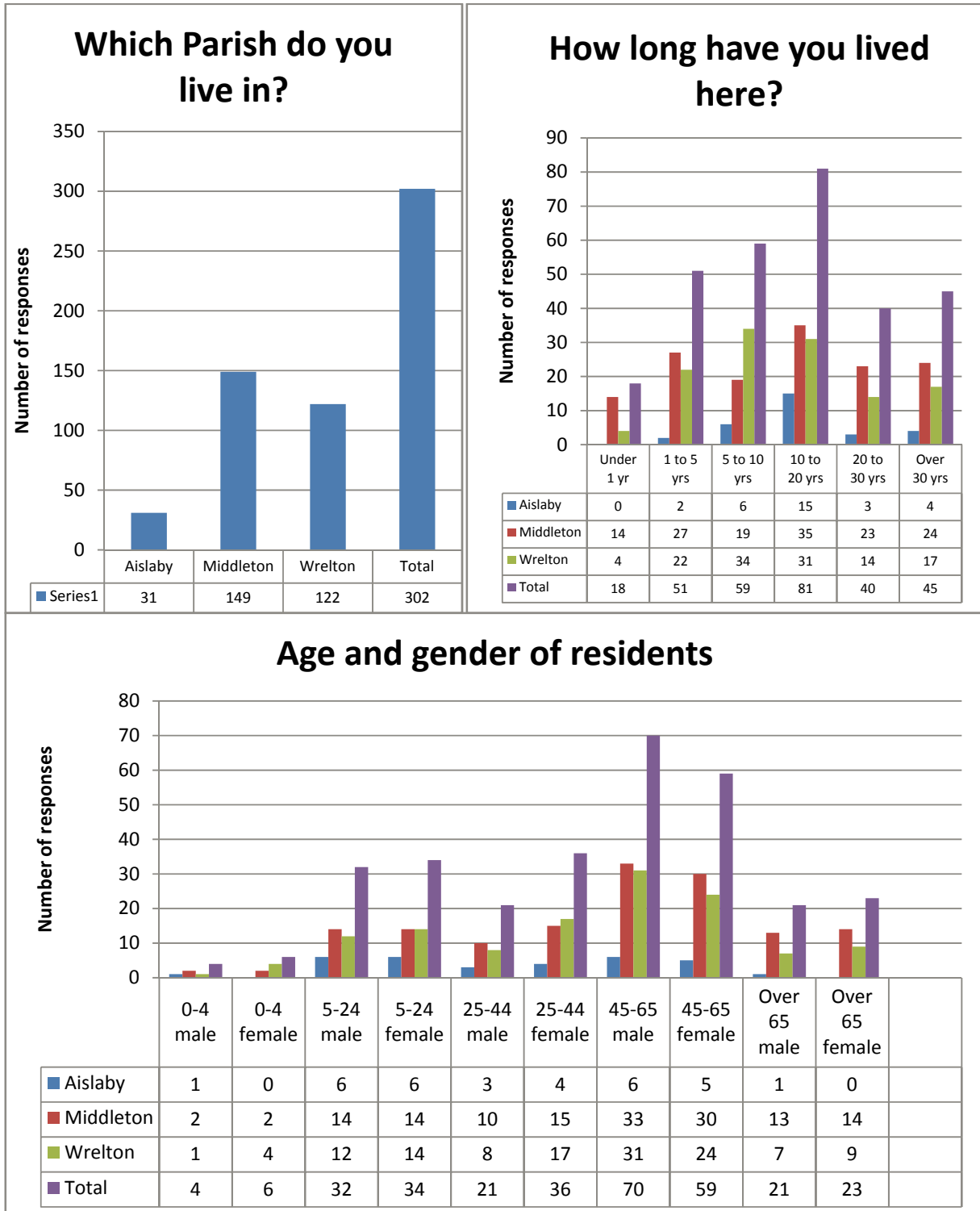
## **Introduction.**

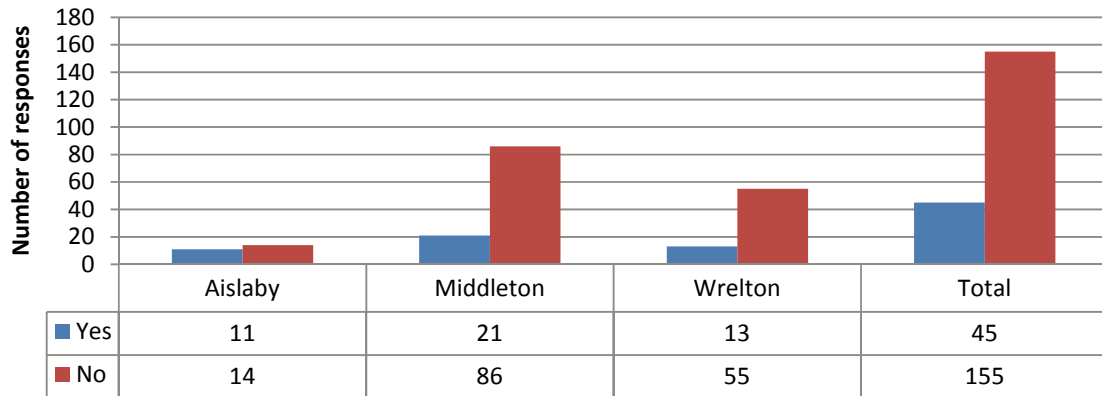

The charts and tables are listed, section by section in the order in which the Parish Plan has been written.

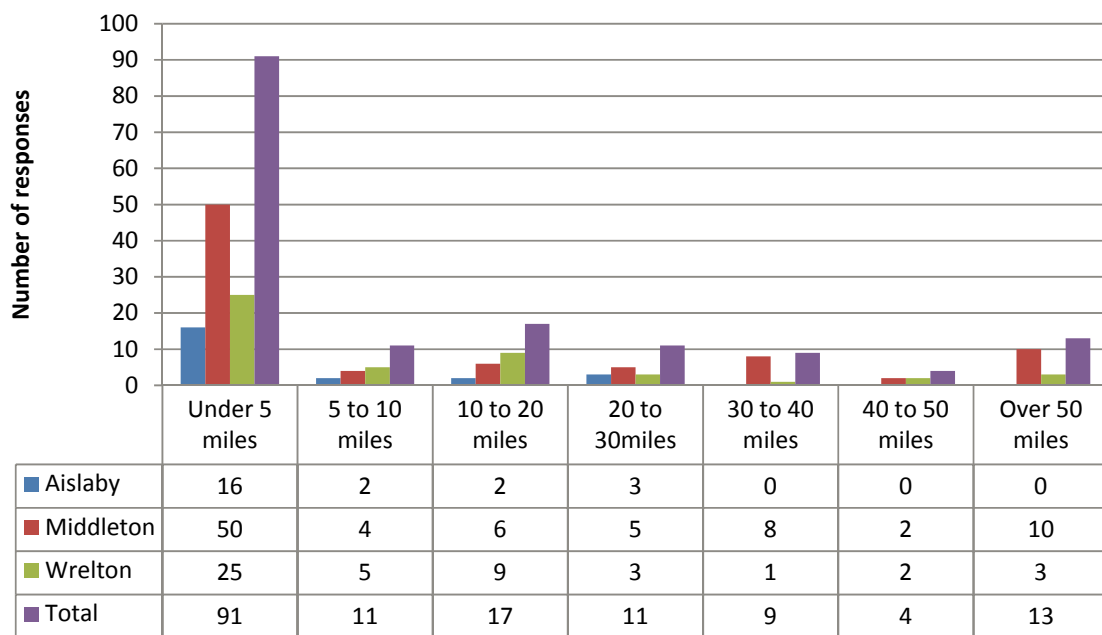

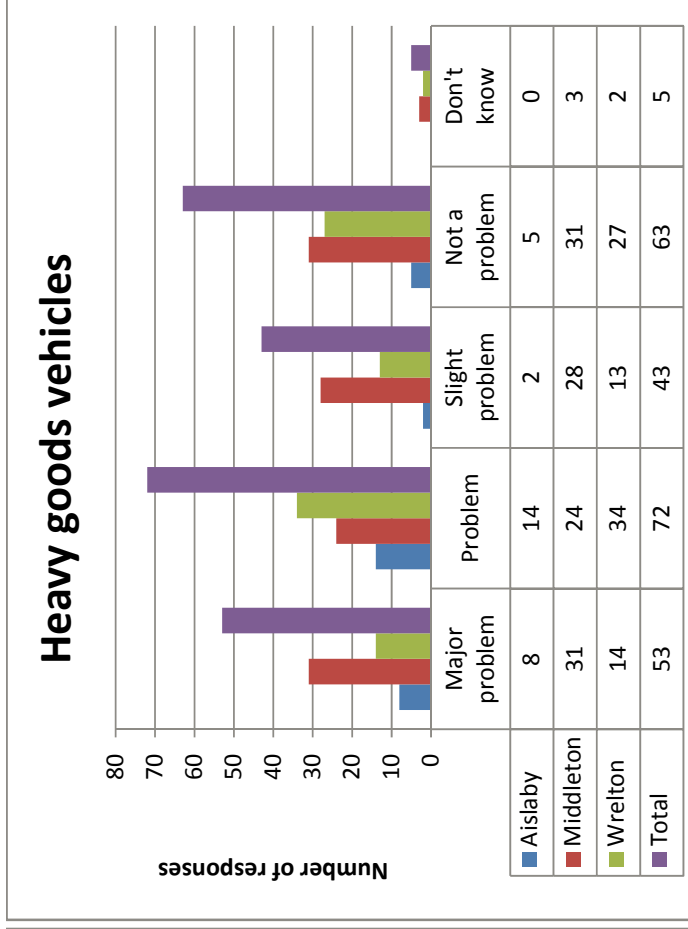
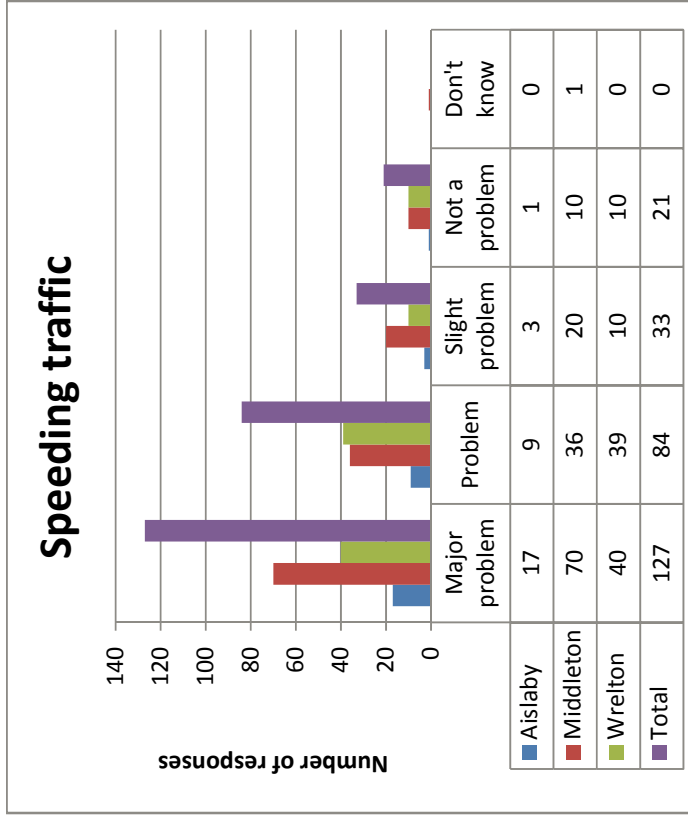
## If you work, do you work within the three parishes?



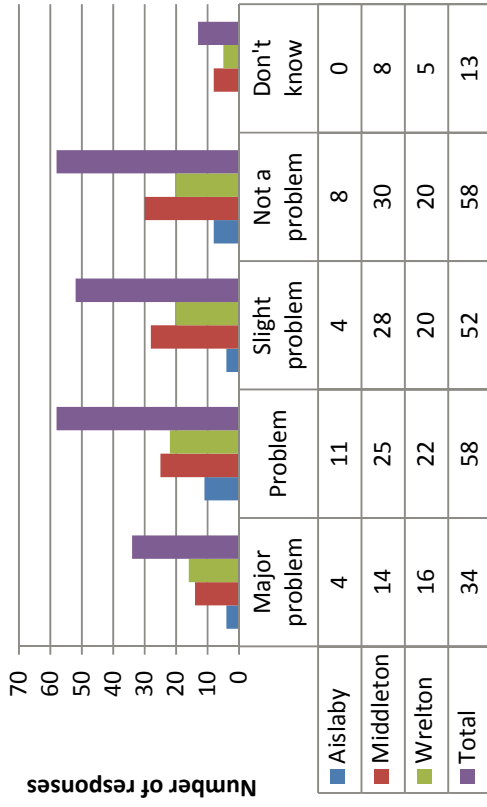
## How far do you have to travel to work (round trip)?



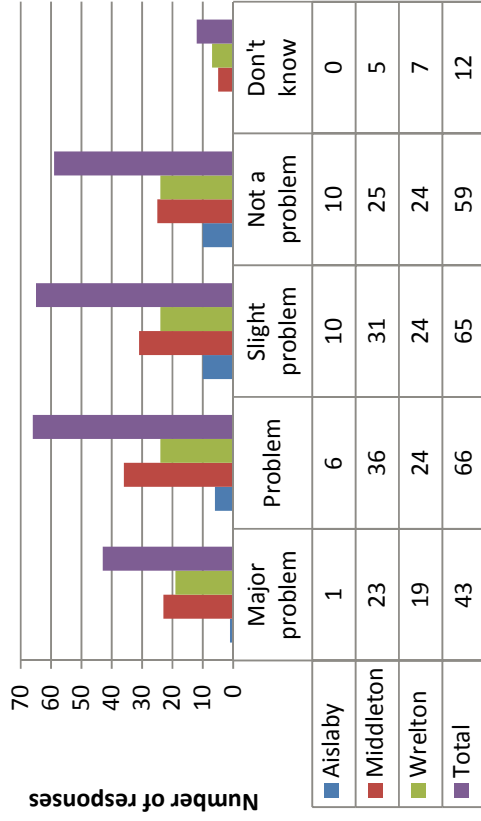

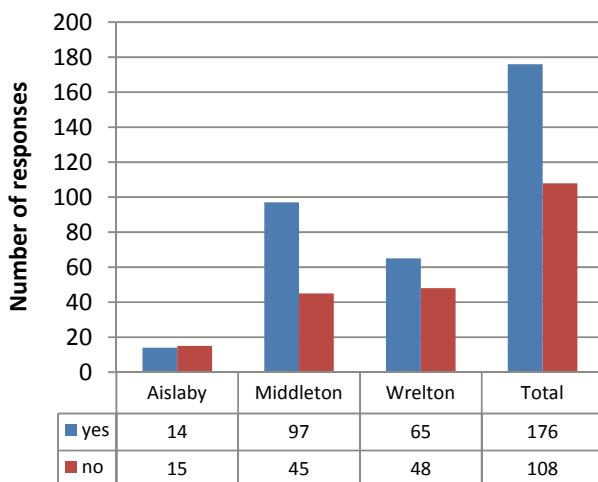

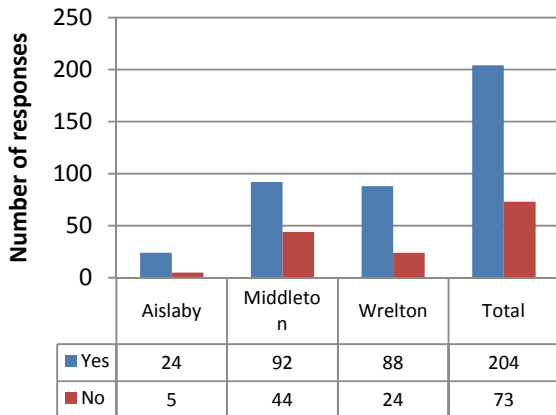

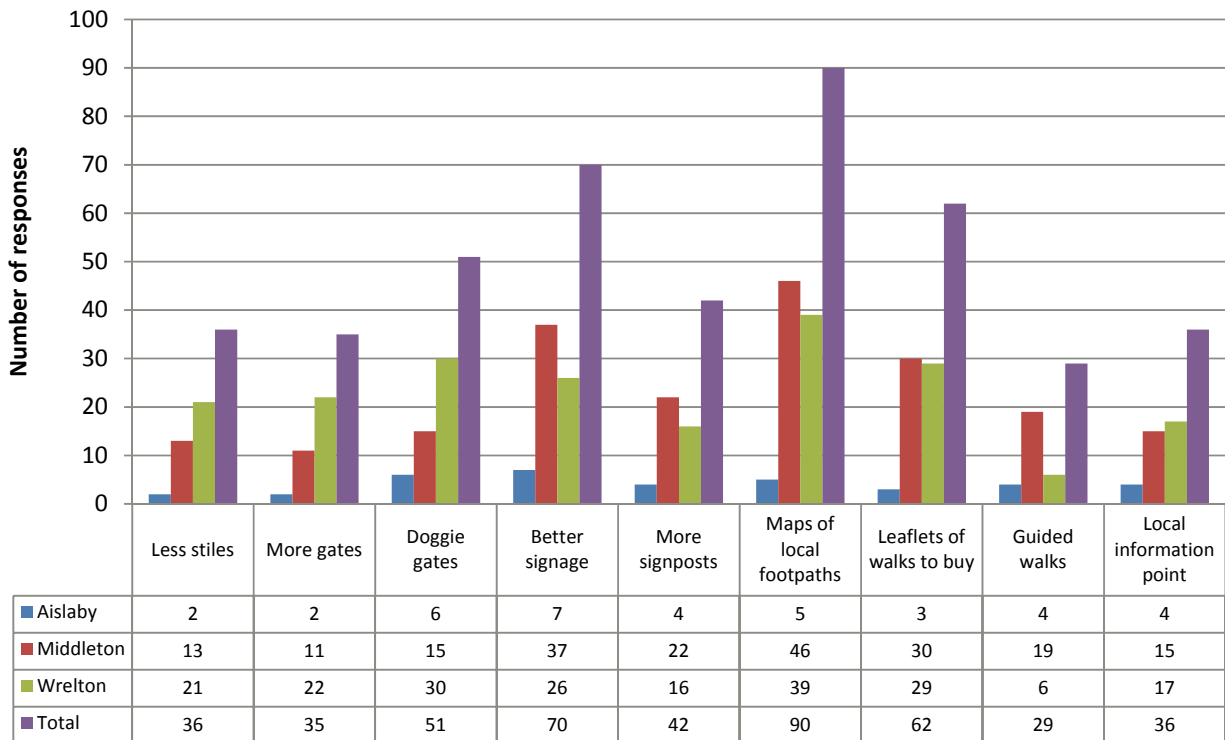
