**GUIDANCE NOTES:** Relief from rates may be available where the following circumstances apply:

- MANDATORY RELIEF** from 50% rates, where the business is:
  - located within a qualifying settlement
  - has a rateable value of no greater than £10,500
  - used as either a: 1) Petrol Filling Station  
2) Public House
  - the only Petrol Filling Station or Public House in the settlement.
- DISCRETIONARY RELIEF** from up to 100% of rates, where a business:
  - is within a qualifying settlement
  - has a rateable value of no greater than £14,000
  - is used for purposes which benefit the local community, and where the District council, at its discretion, considers that such relief would be reasonable, having regard to the interests of the council tax payers. In exercising its discretion, the Council has determined that it will normally expect the following criteria to be met by applicants for this relief. The business will;
    - already qualify for mandatory relief, or
    - meet all other requirements for mandatory relief, and be disqualified only by the existence of one other like business.

**NB. Qualifying settlements are all town/parishes in Ryedale other than Malton, Norton and Pickering.**
