### Funding Opportunities

- **Arts Council Project Grants** - open until April 2021. [Details here](#)
- **The National Lottery Heritage Fund Project Grants** have relaunched. Applications are now open for grants between £3,000-£10,000 and £10,000-£100,000. They are looking for projects with a particular emphasis on organisational resilience and inclusion. [Further details here](#). Larger £100,000+ grants programme to reopen in February 2021.
- **Weston Jerwood Creative Bursaries 2020-22:** Fellowship applications are now open for the Weston Jerwood Creative Bursaries 2020-2022 programme, which will support 50 salaried jobs in arts and cultural organisations across the UK, for individuals from low socio-economic backgrounds. The programme is dedicated to supporting early-career artists, curators, producers and creatives to thrive and develop. The first job opportunities are [now open for applications](#), with the rest to be added between now and March 2021.

- **The John Ellerman Foundation:** Museums and Galleries Fund has opened.
