FOI5927	23-Jul-2019	<p>Please could you help me with 2 pieces/areas of information relating to planning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• During the development of policy SP1 Keldholme was effectively removed from the Kirkbymoorside site submission area, hence in 2017 the production of a new Policies Map for Keldholme (which only includes about 80% of Keldholme in fact). I was recently told by present KMS town councillors that this was largely due to the mayor and one other town councillor who live in Keldholme with open views across field insist Keldholme keep it's hamlet feel during a consultation they recalled. The main thrust of SP1 was to identify areas that were sustainable due to proximity to services, so to remove Keldholme (closer to many services than many service villages ) for character reasons was probably inappropriate and immature – because character matters are better decided in non-strategic policies/processes or indeed in applications. As the SP1 was adopted in 2013, and the map not produced till 2017 the extent of the errors were not clear, so as to make a challenge possible for me at the time. At first I would have to know it had happened and only through making enquiries did I find out. Officer XXX said it was possible to tell because SP1 Said Malton “including Old Malton” and not Kirkbymoorside “including” Keldholme. I then have the problem that Kirby Mills, was included in KMS though, along with 20-90% of Keldholme depending on whether you go by site sift or policies map. I would have like to have this considered in detail by inspectors or ward councillors if it had been possible. I thought I kept an eye on all consultations and completed one and do not remember this point being raised. I know it was mentioned in a consultation paper for a council meeting in 2011 by XXX, but as a minor point among a raft of others put before the council members where Kirby Mills was not even mentioned, despite arguably being further from KMS in it's nearest point than Keldholme (they seem to coalesce on opposite sides of the “Keldholme Only” road. <p>The information I would like to see to make this more transparent to me and easier to cope with (it's a massive source of stress seeing as I was assured going into the process Keldholme was in KMS on more than one occasion and spent lots of time preparing/waiting for a process to unravel that was eventually completely abused by Gladman and a bungling of the buttons on the voting system) is all consultations or responses that supported the removal of Keldholme and the creation of a Keldholme map that splits the village up.</p> <p>It's not like the planning department are particularly forthcoming it's been like getting blood from a stone to get as far as I have. Most of it came through XXX after I made a failed app based on a presumption of being in KMS, and not until after it was done and dusted because I wasn't explicitly made aware until the committee report. He eventually lost his job for which I only heard via a ward councillor speaking to XXX that it might have been because he “wasn't very thorough”. Which I certainly found at times but any complaints fell on deaf ears due to the siege mentality of the department to admit no errors and ignore e-mails from people that question or they look down upon. I think I made an FOI request then which was not answered in time, and eventually dismissed due to being sensitive information.</p> </li> </ul>	Fully Answered

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		<p>• My second relates to items I have requested through the planning department many times but always been ignored. I eventually got some answers via asking my town council to ask, though I didn't believe the response and some of it was in direct conflict to the truth (dates of when it was first looked into etc. Were misleading to the council). This was a barn that was constructed under an agricultural notice 2 fields away from us. It was finally admitted, after lots of delays and 1 last big one to push it over 4 years since built to escape liability, that XXX had made a mistake over the size of the unit, which was only 3 or 4 acres so conferring no such right to build a barn under an agricultural notice. I have consistently asked to see the agricultural notice to understand how the mistake occurred or what the proposed use is. The family are traditionally known as contract farmers so it is possibly classed as a business not an agricultural building anyway so then would most definitely need an application, as they have admitted it did need now to the council. It does not serve the land it is on and contains large tractors, surrounded now by shipping containers in an area of supposed High Landscape Value. The access near to a busy junction was not considered by highways at the time and I suspect the scaling might be larger than would be permissible if the min. extra 7 or so acres required had been present, it does look huge from our property. All I have been given is a letter from H to the owner saying that the plans look fine, but keep the letter in case of a problem. I could not find anything logged on the planning register online when I first looked in 2014 or 15. It was later said this building posed no problems so was not worth enforcing. To me as a neighbour who had a scheme with a smaller barn turned down at a similar time this would have been most useful information and in the interest of fairness and transparency, completely the ideal situation and entirely the lawful action by the planning department who seem to have exceeded their powers and not maintaining their statutory duty to keep public confidence in the planning system with this. Following on from that the source of the error in the size of the unit would also be most useful to know, to see who was either fraudulent or lacking in thoroughness this time. Please could you supply me with the files and plans and notice associated with this matter? It was at Alderstone in Keldholme built around 2014 to 15, the grapevine says for a XXX possibly. Sorry I haven't dug the number out but like I said don't think it was recorded online and it's dragged on a lot of years now. It's probably the 5th time I have asked but usually through various planning officers. To my understanding they had my e-mail, postal address on record and I met the not very stringent criteria of FOI.</p>
